GETTING STARTED

The database is available at Hunter Libraries Online:

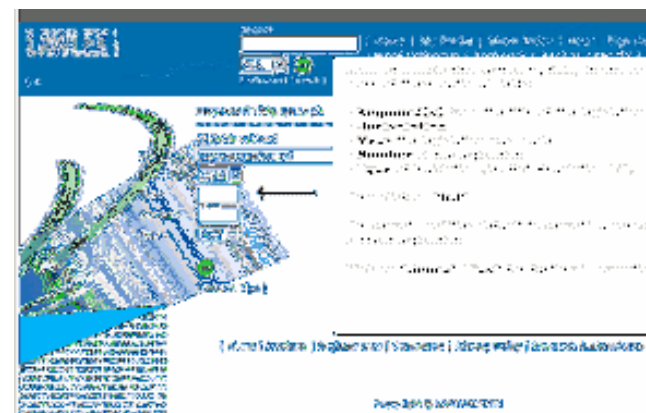

1. Select “**Online Resources**” from the libraries page
2. Select “**Lawlex**” from the list of Online Resources
3. Click on “**Sign In**”
4. Enter the **login** and **password** (Contact your local Hunter Institute Campus Library for the login & password)

USING LAWLEX LEGISLATION – Fulltext current legislation

- A. To find the title of an Act : Use the keyword title search filling in the *jurisdiction* field and the *type* field. Other fields optional. E.g. *crimes, NSW, Act***
- B. To browse names of Acts : Click on Subject Index of Principal Australian Legislation then:**
 - Choose a jurisdiction or state
 - Click on the alphabetical index or an area of law
 - Click on the act of your choice

- Scroll through the act or use the related information headings at the right hand side to find chapters etc.
- **PRINT** or **SAVE** the act by clicking on the icons at the top of the screen.



SEARCHING WITHIN AN ACT

Terms and phrases can be searched for in individual acts once the full text of the act has been displayed.

- Click on *Search Title* (at the top of the screen)
- Type in a word or phrase e.g in the *Crimes Act* search for “stalking” to find the section of the Act that deals with that offence.
