

eResources Information for Students

This program allows students to access resource information relevant to their study such as class notes, Information Booklets, handouts, readings, library guides etc.

eResources can be accessed using the Internet from home or your workplace, however if you are using a computer that does not have the Macromedia software 'Flash' version 5 or greater installed you may not be able to view this site successfully. This software can be downloaded for free from the Internet at <http://www.macromedia.com>. If you do not wish to download this software, you can access the eResources site successfully from all Hunter TAFE library computers.

How to access?

1. Log on to the Hunter Libraries Online site:
<http://www.hunter.tafensw.edu.au>
2. Click onto "Search eResources"
3. If you have a Resource ID number, scroll down the page that appears, type in the number in the Resource ID box and click on search.
4. You can also find documents by filling in any of the other boxes on the Search eResources page. The keyword search will search across all fields. Click "browse" when you have entered your search terms.
5. If the desired resource then appears, scroll down and click on 'Retrieve File' or 'Open URL'.

The resource will appear and you then have the choice to either print it off, save it to a floppy disk or your hard drive or read it from the screen.
