Additional Selection Criteria

The purpose of this additional information for High Demand courses is to assist in the selection process so that the most appropriate students are placed in these courses. Please note that the:

- TVET application form
- the school report and
- this information sheet

will form the basis for the selection process and must be forwarded to the appropriate campus by the close of round 1 – 2nd September, 2011.

The criteria used for this selection is as below.

Criteria	Points
Subject selections (Part 6 TVET Application Form).	10 points
Student statement (Part 7 TVET Application Form)	10 points
Most recent school report (as attached)	20 points
Work Experience (see below)	20 points
Life and Community Experience (see below)	20 points
Total	80 points

Students will be awarded positions in High Demand courses based on their score out of 80.

You may attach evidence to support your work experience, such as a letter of reference from your employer or other documents that details the nature of your employment and experience. You can include long or short term work place experience or related activities.
